## **Coronavirus Updates**

Firstly, we would like to say how much we appreciate how calm and measured all our parents and carers have been in relation to the Coronavirus developments. To clarify with you all, **there have been no confirmed cases of the virus with any Middle Park children, staff or parents.** You will hopefully have received a letter from the Headteacher last Friday which set out the latest guidance received and subsequent advice. This information is also on the school website and Twitter feed. The school is receiving daily updates and we are following the guidance of Public Health England and the current Government. The recent change states that:

- **Anyone with a new and persistent cough and/or a high temperature should self-isolate and stay away from school for at least 7 days**

**This will now be applied to both children and staff moving forward.**

Due to the changing national context and as part of social distancing measures required to reduce the risk of infection, we have decided to make the following changes with immediate effect:

- Year 5 swimming will be postponed until further notice
- Assemblies will no longer take place in school
- The Year 6 trips to Chislehurst Caves will be cancelled as children were due to travel on public transport.
- All parental engagement events will be postponed including the performance of Aladdin and the Maths Open House event on 2<sup>nd</sup> April.

We will continue to keep the community updated via the school website ([www.middlepark.co.uk](http://www.middlepark.co.uk)) and the school Twitter feed (@MPPS\_eltham). In the event of a school closure, all parents will be informed and updated using our school texting service. **As such, it is very important that we have up to date contact information for all our families.** Please let the school know if there has been a change in your mobile number or other contact details.

Please continue to follow official government advice with regard to good hygiene and hand washing to help contain the virus and reduce the risk of it spreading and contact the NHS 111 coronavirus service should you have any concerns.

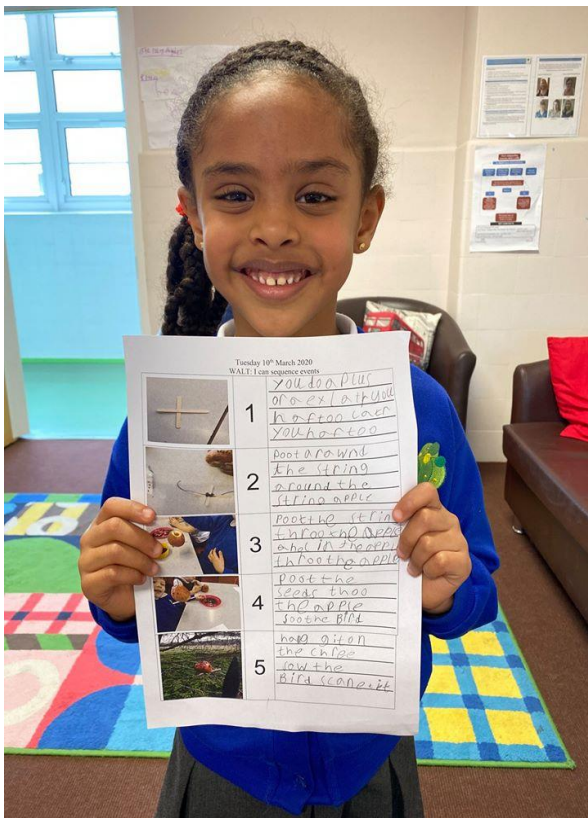
