### Leadership Homework

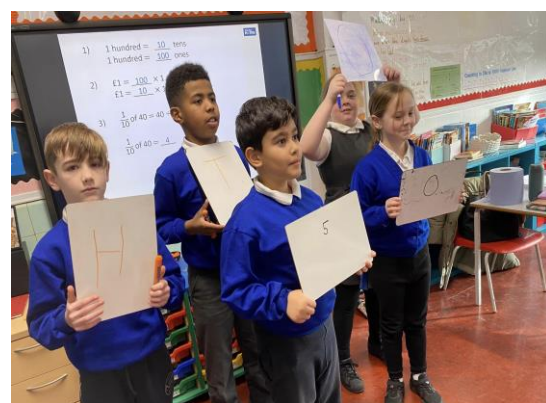
Some homework tasks have already been sent in and it has been wonderful reading about who has been nominated and why.

Year 4 have been embedding their place value knowledge by getting up and active. If we divide a number by ten, we move our digits one column to the right and our number becomes ten times smaller. If we multiply a number by ten, we move our digits one column to the left, add a place holder if we need it and our number becomes ten times bigger. It's important to deeply understand how the value of a digit changes depending on its place.
