School Breakfast Club

From Monday 13th April 2026, the free school breakfast club will begin, offering a 30 minute before-school opportunity every day for all children from FS2 to Year 6. Details have been sent out by the school office.

- The free breakfast club will start at 8.10am each day and will be run from the Middle Park Community Centre (MPCC)
- MPCC staff will walk the children up to school ready to start their school day at 8.45am
- Parents/carers must book their child a place the week before, with Wednesday at 3pm being the cut off day/time
- Booking will be made through the ParentPay app only
- If your child already attends the earlier breakfast club, you should still apply for a place for them each day in order to qualify for a £1 reduction in fees

The booking system is now live for the first week of breakfast club. Please book your child's place before this Wednesday 25th March at 3pm.
