School Breakfast Club

- Children receive a variety of breakfast options throughout the week
- MPCC staff will walk the children up to school ready to start their school day at 8.45am
- Parents/carers must book their child a place in advance
- Bookings will be made through the WEDUC/ParentPay app only under the clubs section
- If your child already attends the earlier breakfast club at MPCC, you should still apply for a place for them on ParentPay in order to qualify for a £1 reduction in fees
