ATTENDANCE



We are a really good school and our parent surveys reflected this. 98% of our parent surveys told us that their child is happy at Middle Park Primary. We really need your help to improve our attendance. Last year we introduced the 100% class attendance each day. This is shared on Weduc and the class receive a small treat for full attendance and a cup will be placed on the class window. We understand that sometimes an absence may be unavoidable. This year we are also introducing another initiative where the children can earn a wrist band for each term. If your child has an attendance of at least 97% they will receive a bronze wrist band, the next term it will be a silver wrist band and the final term it will be a gold wrist band. If your child doesn't achieve the 97% this term, they can always try for bronze in the spring term.

Lets make every child receiving a wrist band a whole school target!!!!
