ATTENDANCE

At Middle Park Primary School, we are highly focused on the pursuit of excellent pupil attendance. In order to access the full curriculum and give your child the best chance of success, they need to attend as close to 100% as is possible, barring legitimate illness. There is clear evidence that children with good rates of attendance have higher attainment than those without. The chart below illustrates the impact of attendance rates on the education of your child.

Rate of Attendance	School days missed over the year (190 days)	What it Means to Your Child
100%	No days missed	Wow! You are amazing!!! There is no risk with your achievement.
97% - 99.9%	1-6 days missed	Well done and keep it up! There is no risk with your achievement.
96% - 96.9%	7-9 days missed	There is a risk of under achievement.
94% - 95.9%	10 - 12 days missed	There is a serious risk of under achievement.
90% - 93.9%	13 – 17 days missed	Your attendance is being monitored. If you near 90% your attendance will start to be monitored by the Local Authority. There is a severe risk of under achievement.
89.9% and below	17.5 days or more missed	You are a 'Persistent Absentee' and your parents/carers could be taken to court as a result of your irregular attendance. Medical evidence will need to be provided to ensure that all absence is authorised. The Attendance Advisory Officer will also be involved. There is an extreme risk of under achievement.
